Goal: Member – AAHKS will expand and diversify the membership

- Member Objective 1: Continue 10 % annual growth Strategies
 - Seek to enroll 100% of Fellows prior to graduation by direct contact through their Program Directors
 - Develop and implement incentives for members recruiting new members

- Automate free membership for residents coming to the resident course
- Increase funding for promotion of AAHKS and its programs in print and digital formats
- Explore promoting collaborative meetings
- Member Objective 2: Review membership categories annually Strategies
 - Review membership categories to ensure they continue to reflect the field of arthroplasty
 - Revise/develop recruiting materials as needed based on the annual review to ensure membership growth goals are met
- Member Objective 3: Conduct biennial member needs assessment
 Strategies
 - Update needs assessment survey questions as needed
 - Create member category specific surveys

Goal: Finance – AAHKS will effectively manage its resources to achieve the Mission

- Finance Objective 1: Develop policy on the level of funds to be kept in reserve Strategies
 - Define what encompasses "reserve"
 - Review benchmarks of comparable associations and create AAHKS policy
- **Finance Objective 2:** Spend available reserves consistent with the established policy to achieve the Mission

Strategies

- Establish a one year budget with a three year projection
- Finance Committee to develop and implement standardized process to apply for available reserve funds
- Create an evaluation methodology to determine the effectiveness of reserve funds spending

Goal: Organizational Capacity – AAHKS will have the organizational capacity to meet member education and advocacy needs

Organizational Capacity Objective 1: Optimize the Association's infrastructure
to enhance member education as it relates to patient care, best practices in
health care delivery and health care policy

Strategies

- Develop and implement an education needs assessment tool
- Evaluate and change, as required, AAHKS' organization structure, volunteer and staff alignment
- Organizational Capacity Objective 2: Ensure that the infrastructure effectively achieves the Association's regulatory and legislative agenda

Strategies

- Align volunteer and staff requirements with the objectives of the regulatory and legislative agenda
- Determine the level of external resources required to advance the regulatory and legislative agenda and align the use of those resources with the AAHKS staff and volunteer structure
- Develop an evaluation methodology to assess the efficacy of the Association's advocacy agenda
