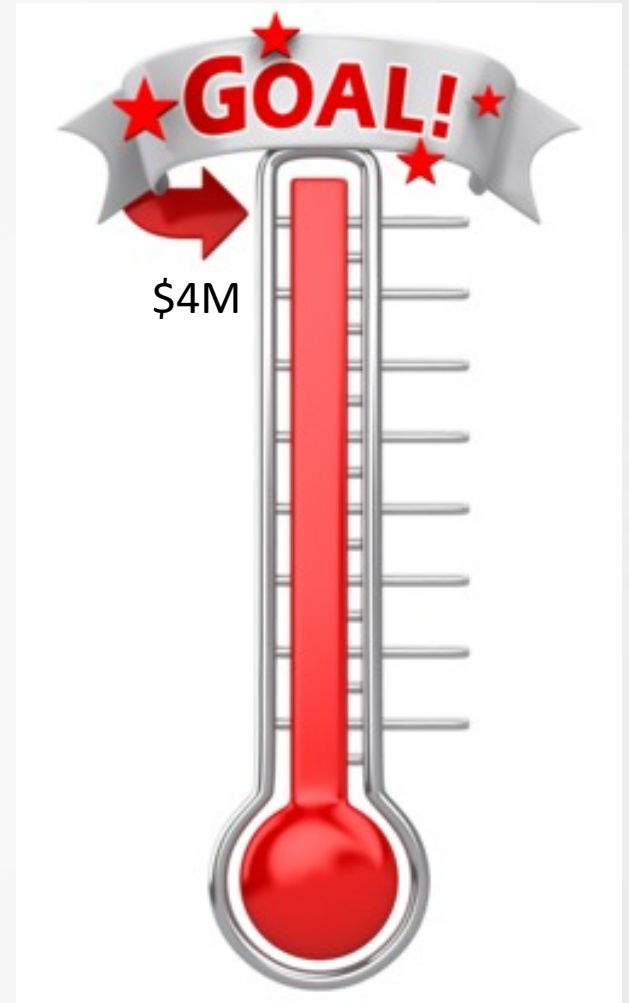

PAC Success in 2019

Orthopaedic PAC had it's best off-election year in our history, raising a record-breaking **\$1.9 million**.

We remain the largest disburser in healthcare. In the 2017-2018 election cycle, OrthoPAC:

- ✓ Raised **\$4 million** (best in our history)
- ✓ Supported over **320** candidates
- ✓ **90%** win rate in US House
- ✓ **86%** win rate in US Senate



PAC Success in 2019

As of December 31, 2019:

- Attended more than **556** political events in Washington, DC
- Hosted **92** political events
- Attended **81** in-district events
- Raised **\$1.9** million through both generous individual/personal and corporate donations
- Secured **9** new Advisor's Circle members, bringing the total to **25** group practices and specialty societies

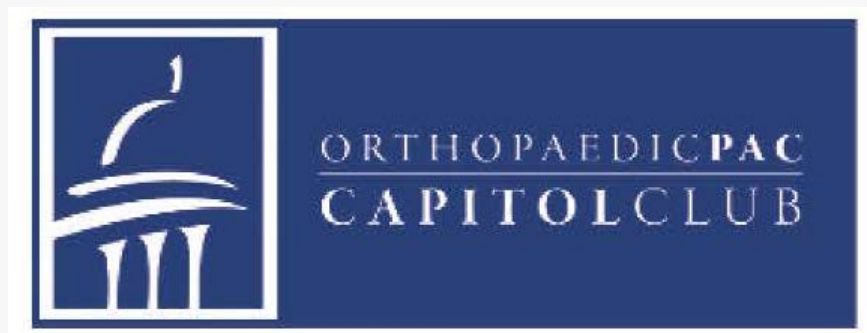

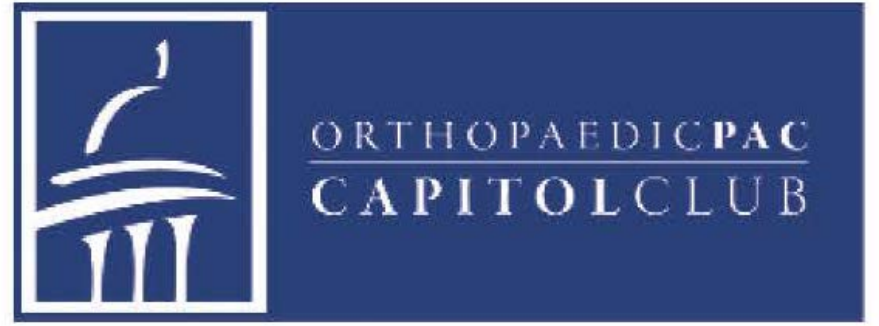


